We are pleased to report that the TerraNova standardized test scores from the Spring have finally been released. We appreciate your patience during the frustrating wait. Enclosed with this letter, you will find instructions on how to access your child's scores online. Please be sure to notice the instructions are different if you have accessed TerraNova scores previously for any of your children versus being a new viewer of TerraNova scores. Let us know if you have any questions about accessing scores.

While it was frustrating to wait for the scores to arrive, we are thrilled with the results which show our students' performance. In the graphs attached, you will find information about each grade level's performance as a whole. These graphs also compare our performance to other schools taking the Spring 2017 TerraNova. To help with reading the graphs:

- Blue column--national percentile for Concord's mean (average) score
- Pink column--national percentile for the mean score of all schools (public and private) in the Southeast
- Yellow column--national percentile for the mean score of Christian schools

It is rewarding to see that Concord's national percentile is the highest in the majority of the grade levels and subtests. We are incredibly proud of the hard work by our students and teachers to achieve such high results.

The attached graphs will also be helpful when looking at your child's test results in comparison to the grade level's performance. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding your child's performance on the standardized testing.
