Concord Christian School was founded as an elementary school in 1996 as a ministry of First Baptist Concord. The middle school opened in 1999 and the dream of a high school was fulfilled in 2009, with our first graduating class in 2013. CCS's core values are biblical truth, intellectual development and potential in Christ integrated with a biblical worldview. **CCS is comprised of 728 students with 192 high school students.**

Graduation Requirements

CCS provides a college preparatory, honors and AP/DE curriculum. Honors classes are offered in all core subjects. AP classes are offered in Calculus, Government, US History, and Chemistry. A minimum of 26.5 credits earned in 9th through 12th grade are required for graduation. Dual Enrollment courses are offered through Bryan College and Pellissippi State for students in the 11th and 12th grades.
