

Full-time Academic Support Teacher needed to teach in our High School for the 2025-2026 school year

Concord Christian School, a ministry of First Baptist Concord, is seeking to hire a full-time Academic Support teacher to teach in our High School (grades 9th-12th) for the 2025-2026 school year. Prior teaching experience is preferred.

The High School Academic Support teacher works with 9th-12th grade students who have a diagnosed learning impairment. Students receive various levels of support depending on the amount of intervention necessary to help them experience success in the classroom. This role has a heavy focus on communication between teachers in order to stay current with assignments, testing, and projects. Also, communication with parents on student progress and upcoming important assignments or assessments is necessary. When working with students, the Academic Support teacher reads information for clarification, provides testing accommodations, helps students work through assignments, aids in scaffolding out work for the week, and checks in on student grades weekly. A background in Special Education is helpful to appropriately accommodate each student's individual needs.
