Concord Christian School was founded as an elementary school in 1996 as a ministry of First Baptist Concord. The middle school opened in 1999 and the dream of a high school was fulfilled in 2009, with our first graduating class in 2013. CCS's Mission Statement: Inspiring students to follow Jesus by equipping them to serve, lead and transfer their world. CCS is comprised of approximately 880 students with approximately 245 high school students.

Graduation Requirements

CCS provides a college preparatory, honors and AP/DE curriculum. Honors classes are offered in English, math, social studies and world language. AP classes are offered in Calculus and Spanish. Dual Enrollment courses are offered through Bryan College and Carson-Newman University for students in the 11th and 12th grades. A minimum of 26.5 credits earned in 9th through 12th grade are required for graduation.
